- o Limited or no verbal communication
- Lacking capacity and understanding
- o Unaware of their rights



- Low self-esteem/self-worth
- Unable to protect themselves
- Institutionalised poor practice
- o Violence, drug abuse, alcohol abuse in relationships
- Disability Isolated individual
- Previous abuse had occurred
